Health & Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ <b>Students who have any symptoms should not report to school.</b> Symptoms of COVID-19 are:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Fever of 100.0°F or higher or chills</li> <li>○ Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing</li> <li>○ Fatigue</li> <li>○ Muscle or body aches</li> <li>○ Headache</li> <li>○ Loss of taste or smell</li> <li>○ Sore throat, congestion or runny nose</li> <li>○ Nausea or vomiting</li> <li>○ Diarrhea</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Morning Entry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ School begins promptly at 8:30 am. All students will be scanned upon arrival and must scan their id card to enter the building. We strongly encourage students to arrive 10-15 minutes early to ensure timely arrival to class</li> <li>★ Students will be allowed to enter the building through the courtyard at 8:15am. Students who arrive early will be placed in the auditorium socially distanced.</li> <li>★ Grab and go breakfast will be available</li> <li>★ Students who arrive after 8:55 am must enter through the front entrance</li> </ul>
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Students will be dismissed at staggered times by floor               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 1st floor - 1:55pm</li> <li>○ 2nd floor - 1:57pm</li> <li>○ 3rd floor - 1:59pm</li> </ul> </li> <li>★ Students will be directed to leave out of the main entrance.</li> </ul>
Discipline (Chancellors Reg: A-443)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Teachers may remove students from class if the student's behavior is substantially disruptive or Interferes with the teacher's authority over the classroom.</li> <li>★ The student may then be removed for 1 to 4 school days by the principal (in consultation with the teacher) for a "single period or entire day" depending on the student's grade level and teacher requesting the removal.</li> </ul>
Cell Phone Policy (Chancellors Reg: A-413)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Students will be allowed to keep their cell phones on their person</li> <li>★ Phones must remain secured and in Airplane mode unless the teacher explicitly authorizes their use (educational purpose)</li> <li>★ Failure to adhere to this policy will result in the confiscation of the device. Device will only be returned to a parent/guardian. Repeated violations may result in the loss of cell phone privileges</li> </ul>
Internet Usage (Chancellors Reg: A-830, 831, 832)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Students are expected to bring their devices everyday to assist with their academic activities</li> <li>★ Both parents and teachers need to help students be good digital citizens. They both need to support students in using the internet in ways that are safe, responsible, and appropriate. They should also help students follow the rules and act in ways that lead to effective digital learning. Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★ Grab and Go bag lunches will be provided to students during their designated lunch periods. Students are allowed to bring food in the building to be eaten for breakfast and during lunch periods.</li> </ul>
